In 2001, Doug Gorman was appointed by Mel Martinez, Secretary of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), to serve on the Manufactured Housing Improvement Act Consensus Committee. Gorman was the only retailer that was appointed to the committee when it was established. He served with 20 other nationally appointed members. Committee members are required under the Manufactured Housing Improvement Act to consider proposed manufactured housing standards and the effects of those standards when compared to the cost of producing such manufactured homes.

Gorman has received his certification from the Manufactured Housing Education Institute, Arlington, VA, as a Professional Housing Consultant (PHC) and has also been certified as an instructor for the course.
